



- **MOST IMPORTANT: Success depends on quality prep work and proper installation. The area must be free from bird droppings and nests. Power washing may be necessary.**

TIP: Droppings continue to attract birds. They indicate a “bird friendly area” and make it welcoming to those that fly by

TIP: Bird droppings carry diseases. Use Personal Protective Equipment when removing and cleaning

- **Using too much product in the beginning is better than too little. Too little allows birds to build a tolerance, requiring more time and money to achieve results.**

TRICK: Initially, use more product spaced closer together

- **Once birds voluntarily re-locate, the maintenance becomes really easy.**

TRICK: Replace expired product right away. This keeps coverage consistent and continues to do your work for you. No fuss, no mess. No harm, no “fowl.” Pouches last 4 –6 weeks, Cubes last 3 months

- **Birds will leave in 3-5 days. During this period you may see birds come and go. Please be patient. EkoCube’s BD-135 is not a force field, but, if the product is being used correctly, birds will not stay long and they will not roost or nest.**

TRICK: Place product closer together where you see birds. Use extra cubes/pouches if available

TIP: Should birds remain after 8 days, contact your consultant quickly to help prevent product tolerance
